AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CITY LOTS 1 AND 2, BLOCK 260, AND PART OF CITY LOTS 1 AND 2, BLOCK 265 OF THE CITY OF DENTON, DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 80-30 (ARTICLE 28A OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Historic Landmark Commission and the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Denton have recommended that the property herein described be designated as a historic landmark in the City of Denton; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON, TEXAS, HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I.

The Oakwood Cemetery located on East Prairie Street known as City Lots 1 and 2, Block 260 and part of City Lots 1 and 2, Block 265 of the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas is hereby designated as a historic landmark under Ordinance No. 80-30, Article 28A of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas.


SECTION II.

The historic landmark designation shall be indicated upon the zoning map of the City of Denton by the letter "H", and the property herein described shall be subject to all of the terms, provisions and requirements of Ordinance No. 80-30, Article 28A of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas.


SECTION III.

This ordinance shall become effective from and after its date of passage.


