PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

I, Joseph Kodim, do hereby declare, under oath, that I am a native-born citizen of the United States of America, and that I am entitled to the rights and privileges of citizenship.

I was born in Graz, Austria, on the 9th day of March, anno Domini 1888. I now reside at 487 S. 7th St., New York City, N. Y.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Hamburg on the vessel Peninsular on the 11th day of May, anno Domini 1902. I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Austria, of whom I am now a subject.

I arrived at the port of New York on or about the 9th day of May, anno Domini 1902.
